## Report: Session on 'Significance of Body Language'

Body language enhances and amplifies the verbal message through gestures, postures and facial expressions. By understanding the effective use nonverbal communication, one can express what one means, connect better with others, and build stronger, more rewarding relationships. The IQAC of HVPS's College of Law organised a session on 'Significance of Body Language' to help students understand that body language can play a major role in Repetition, Contradiction, Substitution, Complementing and Accenting of a verbal message.
